3.1 Discussion of Supportive Services for Veteran Families Draft Plan for the San Luis Obispo (SLO) County Continuum of Care	<p>Laurel Weir provided the SSVF draft plan for feedback. Data on how many Vets served needs to be collected from women's shelters and other places where number of Veteran's served is unknown. The amount of people Klaproad can serve has not been estimated yet.</p> <p>The County VSO office and America's Job Center are both creating positions to assist with this.</p> <p>HUD is looking for a difference in the Point in Time count as a result of this funding, and it could affect future HUD funding if not successful.</p> <p>Morgan Torell from County Planning expressed her approval of the draft plan.</p>			
3.2 Update on Coordinated Intake and Referral Process for entry into Continuum of Care Homeless Assistance programs in SLO County	Laurel Weir provided a draft flowchart for routing Veteran families. Families will be pre-screened and sent to SSVF for screening. If they are chronically homeless they will be sent to HUD VASH or case managed 50. If not they would be sent to CalWORKS			

	<p>if they have children or Klaproad.</p> <p>The Arizona self-sufficiency matrix will be used as the Coordinated Assessment tool to determine whether people will need rapid re-housing or permanent support housing. Home Base will provide training on this and Laurel Weir will contact them about setting this up as soon as possible.</p>		
4. Future Discussion/Report Items	<p>The Mayor's Challenge to end Veteran Homelessness could be something we could look into doing. The VA has offered to go outreach to the mayors about this but we would need to give them more input on what to say. Bob Ellis recommended personalizing this message to our community.</p> <p>Laurel Weir stated that the current meeting time didn't seem to work for people and suggested looking into alternate times for next year.</p>
